Students learnt about the Learning Pit and the struggle to get out of it and along with this we introduced the acronym **GRIT**. We want Mulga Street Kids to be GRITTY. We want them to have **G**uts – Bravery to try something new and give it a go knowing that they may fail. **R**esilience – To brush them-selves off after a disappointment and bounce back. Initiative – the resourcefulness to seek help from others to help with their learning and realise that learning is not about doing it alone and **T**enacity – the inner drive and

This year we will continue to encourage children to have GRIT and teachers will nominate students for acknowledgement during the term assemblies.

Reading needs to be a big focus this year as our data is informing us that we are falling behind 'like schools'. Reading is a basic skill and practice is essential to success. Whilst we listen to children read here at school every day it is impossible for a teacher to listen to every child in their class read out loud every day for 10-15mins. We are urging all families to turn off all devices for 10-15mins each night and read together as a family. The gift of reading is life-long and it costs nothing. If you are able to volunteer your time and listen to children read please speak with your child's teacher. Together we can make a difference.


