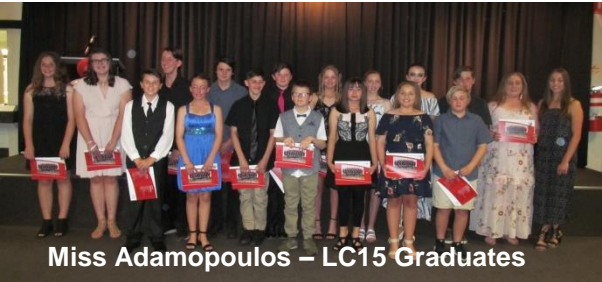


CONGRATULATIONS

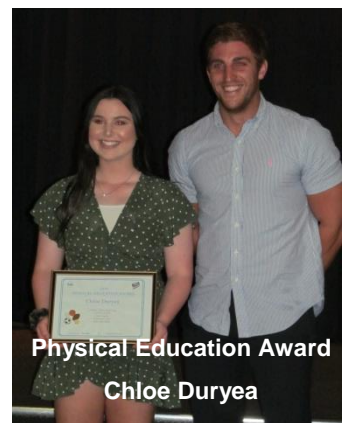

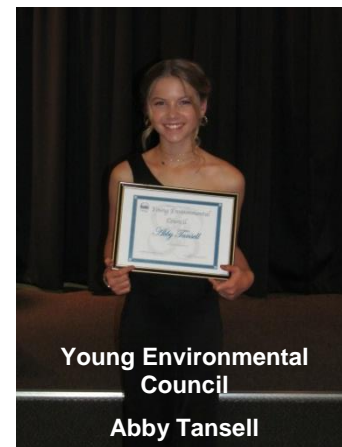

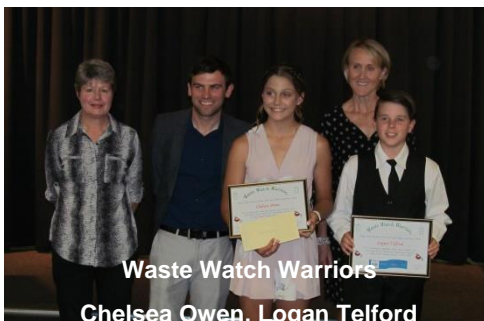
